

Shooting in Coventry Township

On Thursday, May 2, 2024, at approximately 9:00 p.m., the Summit County Sheriff's Office responded to reports of a man with a gun and shots fired on Ostend Avenue in Coventry Township. When the deputies arrived at the scene, they located a male with gunshot wounds who had crashed his vehicle. The alleged shooter was also located at the scene. The Summit County Sheriff's Crime Scene Unit and Summit Metro Crash Team responded to the scene.

Summit County Sheriff's Detectives determined there had been an altercation between the two males which led to the shooting. Subsequently, the male with the gunshot wounds crashed his vehicle. The Coventry Fire Department transported the male to Cleveland Clinic Akron General where he was later pronounced dead. At this time, no charges have been filed. The incident is currently under investigation by the Summit County Sheriff's Detective Bureau.
