

## **Suspect Arrested for Theft of Firearms**

On March 21, 2024, an employee of a gun store in Coventry Township reported a theft of firearms. The theft was discovered by a staff member conducting inventory. It was determined a subject removed two firearms from an unlocked display case while a clerk was distracted. On March 26, 2024, the same suspect returned to the store in the same vehicle and clothing worn during the previous theft. The suspect asked to see a firearm. The clerk kept the suspect distracted while another employee contacted the Summit County Sheriff's Office. The Sheriff's Office responded and identified the suspect as Kyozz Foster, age 21 of Akron. Foster was arrested and charged with Theft from a Federally Licensed Firearms Dealer (F-1). A search was conducted and one of the stolen firearms was located in Foster's vehicle. Foster was transported to the Summit County Jail.
