## **Man arrested During Traffic Stop**

On February 15, 2024, at 8:45 p.m., a Summit County Sheriff's deputy made a traffic stop on South Arlington Road in Springfield Township. A Sheriff's K-9 Unit was deployed to assist with the stop. The passenger, later identified as Solomon Cindea, exited the vehicle. As Cindea exited the vehicle, he dropped a glass pipe. In addition, he initially gave the deputies false identifying information.

Cindea, age 40 of Warren, was arrested for Drug paraphernalia (M4) and False Identifying Information (M1). Cindea also had multiple felony warrants out of the Summit County Sheriff's Office for Theft (F5), Aggravated Possession of Drugs (F5), Identity Fraud (F5), Counterfeiting (F4) and Possession of Cocaine (F5). Cindea was transported to the Summit County Jail.
