Arrest Made in Connection to Vehicle Break-ins

On April 27, 2024, Summit County Sheriff's Deputies were dispatched to the City of Green for multiple reports of thefts from vehicles. The investigation revealed many vehicle break-ins had occurred in the cities of Green and New Franklin. Some of the stolen items included a drone, backpacks, and laptop computers. Sheriff's deputies sent a notice to other law enforcement agencies to be on the lookout for the suspect's vehicle and the stolen items.

A few hours later, the suspect's vehicle was located and stopped by another law enforcement agency in Stark County. The Summit County Sheriff's Detective Bureau responded and obtained a search warrant for the vehicle. Many of the stolen items were recovered and the suspect was identified as Richard Hollenbaugh, age 34 of Canton.

Mr. Hollenbaugh was arrested and charged with multiple counts of Breaking & Entering (F-5) and Theft (F-5). He was transported to the Summit County Jail. Further charges are pending the outcome of the investigation.
